

Registration Options

- Two Ways to Enroll-Paper and Online
- Kindergarten
 - Student needs to turn five on or before September 1,
 2022.
- Transitional Kindergarten
 - Student needs to turn five between September 2, 2022
 and February 2, 2023.
- Extended Transitional Kinder
 - Student must turn five between February 3, 2023 and June 8, 2023.
 - Extended TK is based on space availability. TK students receive priority over Extended TK students.

Medications

- School CANNOT dispense medication unless it has been prescribed by a physician and with written permission of the parent.
- Medication must be in their original prescription container which has the student name and dispensing directions.
- All medications are kept in the front office.
- Notify front office and teachers of any medical conditions and/or allergies.

- ★ Minimum Days for TK and K
 - o August 17th-19th
 - o Times: 8:25-11:41 a.m.
- ★ Regular Schedule--Beginning Week of August 22nd

Morning Drop-Off

Student supervision begins

- @ 7:45 am on the kindergarten playground and in the cafeteria. Students line up on the sidewalk
 - @ their class spot when bell rings.

Afternoon Pick-Up

- Safety is #1!
- Students are picked up along the front outer wall of the cafeteria.
- Bus riders are escorted to the bus lines.
- Students attending Boys and Girls Club are escorted by B&G Club staff.
- Teachers only release to designated family members, day care providers and/or friends.

Student pick-up and drop-off in yellow zone in front of school.
